

ACCOMMODATIONS

for Parents Accompanying their Child for Assessment

Welcome to APSEA

During your child's assessment at the APSEA Centre, accommodations, meals and parking are provided at no charge.

A package containing necessary security and parking passes, meal vouchers and room keys will be provided upon your arrival. Parents arriving on Sunday cannot gain access to the building until 6:00 p.m. Parents are requested to vacate their bedroom by 9:00 a.m. on the day they are scheduled to leave so that housekeeping staff can prepare the room for the next occupants.

APSEA is a smoke-free and scent-free environment.

Lodging

A private bedroom, suitable for two adults and one child, will be provided in an apartment which is shared with other parents and children. The common area contains a furnished livingroom, eating area and fully equipped kitchen and washroom. Food is not provided in the kitchen as meals are served in the cafeteria. Alarm clocks and towels are provided; please bring your own toiletries. Cribs and bedrails are available with prior notice.

The fire regulations are posted on the back of the main door of the apartment. Please familiarize yourselves with these rules.

Meals

Meals are served in the cafeteria three times daily:

Breakfast: 7:30 - 8:30 am

Lunch: 12:00 - 1:00 pm

Supper: 5:00 - 5:45 pm

Any special dietary concerns should be communicated to the itinerant teacher at least two weeks prior to the assessment.

Playground

There is a playground adjacent to the APSEA residence building, which parents and children are invited to use. The play area is fenced and locked. A key to this playground is available through the assessment department and must be returned each time it is used.

Parking

Parking is provided on the APSEA premises. Parking passes must be displayed in the front window of your vehicle. Tickets are issued for cars not displaying proper permits.

Local Conveniences

Located within a 5-20 minute walk are various conveniences and tourist attractions: malls, boutiques, coffee shops, convenience stores, theatres, the Halifax waterfront, restaurants, etc. Metro Transit buses provide

regular service throughout Halifax and the surrounding areas.
